

Douglas Mood Memorial Scholarship

The applicant must:

- Be a graduating senior of Ishpeming High School
- Have a minimum 3.00 GPA during the first seven (7) semesters at Ishpeming High School (Transfer students are eligible if they meet the GPA requirements)
- Pursuing a four (4) year degree in Education or Engineering at either Northern Michigan University or Michigan Technological University.

Candidates will be judged on academic standing and citizenship.

A committee made up of the high school principal, guidance counselor, senior level math teacher and senior level science teacher will choose the recipient of this award.

The amount of this scholarship is to be a minimum of \$1000 annually.

The scholarship is a one-year, non-renewable scholarship.

Applications must be turned into the counselor's office no later than April 1st.

Funds shall not be given to the recipient without proof of enrollment at Northern Michigan University or Michigan Technological University.
